The Florida PTA Leadership Certificate Program (LCP) is intended to recognize individuals’ preparation to hold positions of responsibility in PTAs at every level. Each applicant must complete training in required areas; attend at least one county, state or national conference or convention; and complete at least one PTA-related activity that provided an opportunity to develop leadership skills and apply the knowledge gathered from training. Activities include serving as chairperson of a committee, as an officer or in some other leadership position within the previous six months.

Training will include a total of five (5) credits in the following specific curriculum areas:

2 in Organizational Structure and Performance (OSP)

Areas of emphasis will include parliamentary procedure, bylaws, strategic planning, membership, program planning and other topics.

1 in Finance (FIN)

Areas of emphasis will include budgets, resource development, taxes, financial management and other topics

1 in Advocacy (ADV)

Areas of emphasis will include legislation, platforms, lobbying, program advocacy and other topics.

1 in any area or an Enrichment area (ENR)

Curriculum Standards will be developed for each area to assure consistent training statewide. Credit eligible training will be offered at all Florida PTA conferences and convention. Additionally, Regions and County Councils will be provided with training materials to use in their training.
